Dear Parent / Guardian,

We have been informed, that on Friday afternoon, May 25th 2012 the Olympic flame will be passing through the Pontypool area. The information has come from Torfaen and the organisers of the route; the timing of the event, along with the road closures arranged, means that our school buses would be held up for a considerable time on the hill down to Pontypool. We are obviously concerned about the implications of this for our pupils, since some of them are on the buses for a considerable length of time on a normal day.

We have, therefore, consulted with the Governing Body and have decided, on Health and Safety grounds, to change the In Service Training Day from Friday the 4th of May to Friday the 25th of May. This has implications for pupils sitting external examinations on Friday the 25th of May and we are working with the bus companies to ensure that pupils with examinations can come in to school as usual on that day. We will meet with the pupils concerned to discuss the day's arrangements.

We are aware that many of you will have made arrangements already for the 4th of May, however this will now be a normal school day and any unavoidable absences should be noted to us either in advance or on the day. Should you need to make arrangements for your child for Friday the 25th of May, hopefully this gives you enough notice.
